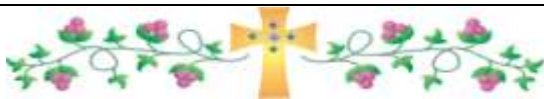

## LENTEN REGULATIONS FOR 2012

Ash Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> &  
Good Friday, April 6.

**Days of Fast and Abstinence:** No Meat. Limit of one full meal on these days for all who have completed their 18<sup>th</sup> year and have not reached their 60<sup>th</sup> year.

**Days of Abstinence:** (All Fridays in Lent.) No meat for all who have completed their 14<sup>th</sup> year.

**Week Days of Lent:**

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

**Easter Duty Obligation:**

Must be made from the first Sunday in Lent, February 26<sup>th</sup> through Trinity Sunday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. Confession and Holy Communion at least once during this time.

**Voluntary Self Denial:**

May include, in addition to fasting, participation in daily Mass, spiritual reading, Lenten Devotions, Stations of the Cross, praying the Rosary, deeds of mercy and kindness.
